WAIVER, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, AND AGREEMENT TO HOLD HARMLESS

I understand that attendance at a dog training activity is not without risk to myself, members of my family or guests who may attend, or my dog, because some of the dogs to which I (we) will be exposed may be difficult to control and may be the cause of injury even when handled with the greatest amount of care. I hereby waive and release Teamworks Dog Training, its officers, employees, owners, members, and agents from any injury or damage resulting from the action of the dog, and I expressly assume the risk of any such damage or injury while attending any training session or while on the training grounds or the surrounding area thereto. In consideration of and as inducement to the acceptance of my application for training I hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless release Teamworks Dog Training, its officers, employees, members, and agents from any and all claims, or claims by any member of my family or any other person accompanying me to any training session or while on the grounds or the surrounding area thereto as a result of any action of any dog, including my own.

I agree to abide by the policies of Teamworks Dog Training listed below:

- ◆ I have filled the class application out with information that is honest and complete.
 - **Domestic Dogs:** Any canid that is part wild canid and that is not 100% domestic dog will not be allowed on either property.
 - **Dangerous Dogs:** Any dog which, in the opinion of Teamworks Dog Training, is uncontrollable, unpredictable, aggressive, or in any way a danger to people will not be allowed in regular group classes and will be referred for specialty behavior classes or private consultation. A refund for the remaining classes will be given or applied to the specialty behavior class or private consultation.
 - **Youth:** Anyone aged 7 -17 participating in classes must have a parent or responsible adult in attendance at all times. Children under 7 years of age must be accompanied by a non-participating adult at all times while on the premises. Children and visitors are welcome in any our our core classes. However, no visitors or children are allowed in Dominant Dogs or Fearful Fidos class – only adult handlers over the age of 18 may attend.
 - **Dogs on Leash:** All dogs must remain on leash when on the premises of the training facilities and not working inside the building or the inside fenced agility ring.
 - **No Unsolicited sniffing:** We ask all owners to be aware of their dog's behavior while on leash. All handlers are asked to not allow their dog free access to sniff another person's dog without asking permission of the owner first.
 - **Humane Treatment:** Any person using the facilities of Teamworks Dog Training must agree to use humane training methods that would reflect the Teamworks Dog Training philosophy. Specifically, no shock collars will be allowed, no ear-pinching, and no harsh or inhumane treatment of dogs (including but not limited to hanging, strangling, choking, kicking, dragging, beating, hitting, striking, slamming, throwing or any other pain-inducing method).
 - **Clean Up :** All handlers ***must clean up after their dogs*** when on the premises of the training facilities. This includes scooping all solids in either location left any place on either property. This also includes using the disinfectant spray bottles provided for all urine in the indoor location, and anywhere on the agility field, including the enclosed sand, the agility equipment, and the fence.
 - **Females in Heat:** Female dogs in heat should not be brought on the grounds of either facility. Handlers can be re-scheduled into the next available class if this occurs without incurring extra charges.
 - **Swimming:** The doggie swimming pond is for dogs only. No humans may swim, wade, or dive into the pond.
 - **Pond Rules:** I agree to abide by all of the pond rules as LISTED ON THE BACK SIDE OF THIS PAGE.

• **Rules for the Pond Include:**

- **1. ALL DOG EXCREMENT MUST BE REMOVED AND DISPOSED OF PROPERLY IN AND AROUND THE POND.**
- **2. NO DOGS IN HEAT ALLOWED IN OR AROUND THE POND OR ANYWHERE ON THE GROUNDS.**
- **3. NO FEEDING OF BIRDS OR FISH IN THE POND. NO TOSSING FOOD MATTER OF ANY KIND IN THE WATER.**
- **4. ***NO HUMANS MAY WADE, SWIM IN OR DIVE IN THE POND.*****
- **5. ANY DOG USING THE POND MUST BE CURRENT ON RABIES, BORDETELLA, AND DHPP VACCINATIONS AND MUST NOT HAVE CHRONIC COUGHING, ANY DIARRHEA, OR ANY VOMITING.**
- **6. NO FISHING IN THE POND.**
- **7. DOGS WITH A FRESH FRONTLINE-TYPE APPLICATION (LESS THAN 48 HOURS) MUST BE BATHED BEFORE SWIMMING IN THE POND (HOSE PROVIDED).**
- **8. NO DOGS OFF LEASH IN ANY OTHER PLACE BUT THE FENCED POND AREA.**
- **9. AGGRESSIVE OR UNRULY DOGS OR DOGS RUNNING OUT OF THE POND AREA OFF LEASH WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE.**
- **16. PLEASE ALLOW 2 HOURS AFTER YOUR DOG EATS BEFORE SWIMMING YOUR DOG.**
- **17. THERE IS NO GUARANTEE THAT THIS POND WILL BE FREE OF SNAKES OR SNAPPING TURTLES. PLEASE MONITOR YOUR DOG CLOSELY.**
- **18. THERE IS NO GUARANTEE THAT THIS POND WILL REMAIN FREE OF PARASITES LIKE GIARDIA. IF YOUR DOG SHOWS SIGNS OF VOMITING OR DIARRHEA, PLEASE SEE YOUR VETERINARIAN AND INFORM TEAMWORKS IMMEDIATELY.**
- **20. THERE IS NO PEOPLE SWIMMING ALLOWED IN THE POND. ANYONE USING THE POND ASSUMES ALL RISKS ASSOCIATED WITH SWIMMING AND WATER. THERE IS NO LIFE GUARD ON DUTY. The closest emergency veterinarian is 30 minutes away (Quail Corners (919) 876-0739 | 1613 E Millbrook Rd Raleigh, NC 27609) and the closest people hospital is 20 minutes away (Franklin Regional Medical Center (919) 497-8410 | 100 Hospital Dr Louisburg, NC 27549).**
